



## SAINT FRANCIS de SALES SCHOOL

### CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. The student should have the basics of English, both spoken and written. We have a limited E.S.L. program at St. Francis de Sales School. After acceptance into St. Francis de Sales a student may be required to attend E.S.L. classes after school hours. (at an additional cost)
2. To apply for admission to St. Francis de Sales School:
  - Please complete the attached Application Form  
**Please note: Submitting this form does not indicate acceptance of St. Francis**
  - Please attach your most recent transcript (in English) of all academic marks
  - Please attach a copy of Health Insurance coverage (MSP) or valid insurance
  - If residing in Canada, please attach a copy of your guardian's Canadian Citizenship Landed Immigrant document.
3. An appointment should be set up with the Principal, the student applying and the guardian.
4. Upon acceptance the tuition is due in advance.

**Tuition cost is \$ 10,000 per year (tuition fee) plus \$1,000.00 Administration fee (non-refundable)**

**The Administration fee includes Registration, Parent Participation fee, Student planner and school supplies.**

This fee **does not** include the cost of the student's uniform. The uniform is available for purchase through Neat Uniforms. Order information will be given.

Other incidental expenses may be incurred from time to time throughout the school year. E.g.: class activities, Outdoor Education (Gr. 7), charity events, fundraising etc.

**Upon receipt of tuition, a Letter of Acceptance will be issued. The tuition is not refundable.**

5. For a student applying from outside the country, this letter will be sent to the applicant and they should apply for a Student Visa at their nearest Canadian Immigration office. This process can take 6 – 8 weeks. A copy of the Student Visa must be sent to St. Francis de Sales School as soon as it is received.
6. We have no dormitory facilities at St. Francis de School. The student should reside with an English speaking family.
7. Standards regarding absenteeism and participation in extra-curricular activities should be agreed to at the time of application. Chronic tardiness and absenteeism will be dealt with very seriously and the student could risk losing their "Student Visa" status in Canada.
