Walkathon 2022 Info Sheet

The Walkathon is almost here! Remember that our theme this year is inspired by Pope Francis' visit to Canada to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples. We invite everyone to reflect on what it means to walk and journey with Indigenous Peoples of this land on the path to healing and reconciliation. A portion of funds raised will be donated to the *Archbishop's Campaign for Healing and Reconciliation* to support Indigenous-led projects.

Who can take part in the walkathon?

Everyone in the community is welcome to participate! Kindergarten to Grade 7 students, parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, pets (on leashes), pastors and principals, and even gnomes!

When and where is the walkathon?

The Walkathon takes place on Friday, October 7 at **Deer Lake Park.** Students should arrive at 8:45 AM and check in with their teachers at the starting point near the swing sets.

What will happen at the walkathon?

- Students will check in with their classroom teachers upon arrival at the parking lot, travel the routes, and take part in the fun activities along the way.
